Abilities needed for all Council Members:

- A. Faith Witness
 - Practicing Catholic Christian
 - Willing to share faith publically
 - Openness to growth in faith, maturity, and spirituality
- B. Organization Abilities
 - Able to work with others and appreciate other ideas, cultures, and opinions.
 - Able to collaborate with others to solve problems.
 - Able to work well with target dates.
- C. People Skills
 - Appreciation of our Church, young adults, and the Vision and Goals of Young Adult Ministry in the Archdiocese of New Orleans.
 - Assertive, willing to lead others
 - Able to actively listen and communicate effectively
- D. General Responsibilities
 - Attend monthly Young Adult Council Meetings: August 2017-July 2018
 - Advocate for Young Adult Ministry within your parish and the Archdiocese.
 - Be a conduit for information between the council and the parish.
 - Participate as actively as possible in diocesan young adult events.
 - Be willing to lead ministry within the diocese.

Council Application Process:

- To be considered for the Young Adult Council, an applicant must either live, work, study, and/or worship in the Archdiocese of New Orleans and be between the ages of 18-39. One must also demonstrate the ability to speak and advocate on behalf of one's peers, work collaboratively with other young adults, and be open to using one's spiritual gifts, talents, and leadership abilities in the service of the Catholic Church.
- Young Adults may apply on their own or be nominated by parish, campus ministry, or diocesan leaders. All applications will be reviewed by the Young Adult Ministry staff. Applicants may be interviewed or asked for follow-up information, if necessary. All applicants will be contacted with the final decision via phone or email.
